IT IS ORDERED that during the pendency of this action the above-named defendants, and each of them, and their officers, agents, board members, employees, representatives, and all persons acting in concert or participating with them, are enjoined and restrained from engaging

in, committing, or performing, directly or indirectly, by any means whatsoever, any of the following acts:

Holding an election for the Parbandhak Committee (board of directors), approval of construction-related expenditures exceeding \$250,000, or amendment of the bylaws of the defendant Gurdwara, presently noticed and set for September 22, 2019.

The court reserves jurisdiction to modify this preliminary injunction as the ends of justice may require. This preliminary injunction shall remain in effect pending further order of the court, including but not limited to a final determination of the merits of the above-captioned complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, before this order shall take effect, plaintiffs, no later than twelve noon, September 20, 2019, file with the court an undertaking, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure §529, in the amount of \$60,000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall appear for a status conference on September 20, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12. The parties are free to take the status conference off calcular by stipulation in the event that both are satisfied that the required undertaking has been posted.
