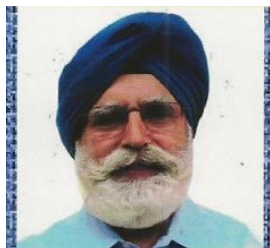




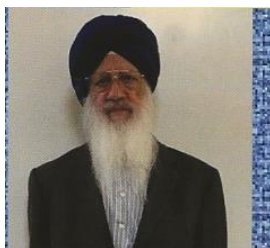
Sukhdev Singh Bainiwal

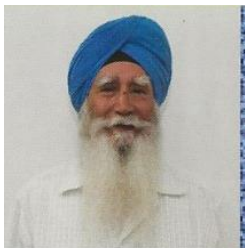
Dr. Gurinder Pal Singh

I helped in selling Quimby Road property at the right time to a developer for ten million dollar at the highest market value. I played a leading role in getting the city approval, constructing and financing the present Gurdwara Sahib complex. I helped in saving Gurdwara Sahib over \$10,000,000 (\$10 million) by sub-contracting all the constructions to small contractors and personally managed the project. I helped in finding \$13,500,000 (\$13.5 million) financing at 2.75% interest rate per annum. As a result \$2,000,000 (\$2 million) principle has been paid off in the four years period. \$3,000,000 (\$3 million) solar system was installed at zero cost to the Gurudwara sahib that provides electricity at 18% less cost than PG&E rate. Eventually, Gurdwara Sahib will own the system. My vision for future is to build Sikh Heritage garden and Guru Nank Pag- Dandi project on the hill behind the complex with Government assisted funding. Senior & affordable housing project including a Community Center with shared parking is possible by lobbying the Government officials, also with Government assisted funding's. I wished to do sewa in developing these communities' projects including Khalsa School to a K-12 school and a community owned Funeral Home.

ਹਰਦੇਵ ਸਿੰਘ ਤੱਖਰ

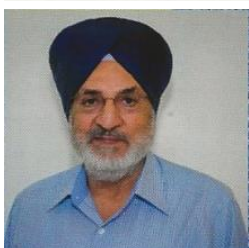
My name is Hardev Singh Takhar, currently serving on the board as a Chairman and working with maintenance committee.

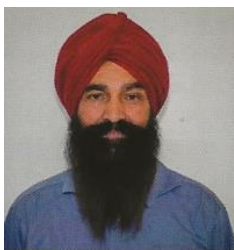
Rajinder Singh Manger

ਡਾ. ਬਲਬੀਰ ਸਿੰਘ ਬੈਂਸ

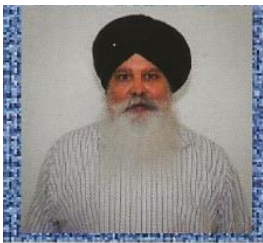
